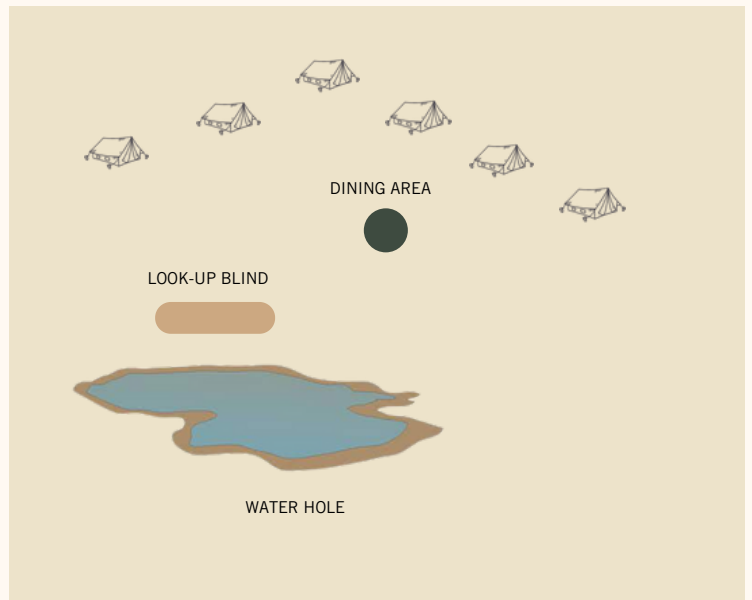




'Remote and exclusive' takes on new meaning when describing Jozibanini. The camp is located in the far south-west of Hwange National Park, in a wilderness area previously unvisited by tourists and neglected by park authorities. We have built a simple camp that harkens back to the yesteryear of safari travel, and we keep the pace deliberately leisurely, taking time on walks, in the hide, and even on short bike rides along game trails between fossil dunes.



Location

With the nearest safari lodge 50 km away, guests staying at Jozibanini will not see another tourist. The camp is located in the Southern Wilderness Area of the park – camp co-ordinates are: South 19 23 02.17 / East 026 45 27.99.

BY ROAD

Six hours by road from Bomani, Camelthorn or Nehimba, taking a game drive through the park with a picnic lunch en route.

BY AIR

One hour by light aircraft from Victoria Falls or Bulawayo; half an hour from any other Imvelo property. Libuti Airstrip – South 19 27 01.4 / East 026 46 51.1 – open seasonally, sand/clay surface. Road transfer to camp 15 minutes.

Activities

Activities at Jozi are designed to give guests a change of pace, allowing for quiet observation; never just searching for the next species. Take time to track game on foot, lose track of time in the Look-up sunken hide watching the passing parade of wildlife, or take a short bike ride to get the heart pumping!

Accommodation

5 x Barrel Tents on raised decks: 20 sq m tents on wood platforms overlooking the lodge waterhole. Three twin rooms with two $\frac{3}{4}$ beds, and two double rooms each with one double bed, open-air bathroom ensuite with bucket shower.

1 x Ground Level Tent: 25 sq m tent with two $\frac{3}{4}$ beds, open-air bathroom en suite with bucket shower.

Jozi 'Star Bed' Experience: beds can be moved onto the veranda allowing guests to sleep under the stars!

Game drives – timing will vary with the season and sightings of special interest, using open 4x4 vehicles specially adapted for unimpeded photography. **Pump runs** – Imvelo manages 18 water points for the wildlife of Hwange. Any movement to and from (and around) Jozi includes calling at waterholes along the way to check on the pump attendants and maintain our innovative solar/diesel hybrid pumping stations. **Game walks** will be taken by an experienced guide for a more intimate experience of the sounds and scents of the wild.

The Look-up – our unique sunken hide gets guests up close to Hwange’s gentle giants, providing an unforgettable perspective and great opportunities for photography. **Mountain biking** – ancient sand dunes, now settled with vegetation, are separated by shallow valleys where elephant paths have compacted the terrain, allowing for biking. Take a short 5 to 10 km ride in the morning followed by brunch under a shady tree, before heading back to camp.

St Joseph’s School – by special arrangement, guests can visit St Joseph’s outside the park (20 km by road) and meet the students and teachers of one of the most remote schools in the district, now supported by Imvelo.

Facilities & Amenities

The campfire is the focus of this camp – there is no dining room; all meals are taken around the campfire, hosted by your guide sharing memorable tales of wild Africa. Limited solar power provides for lighting and standing fans; limited wifi service; no cell phone reception. All rooms have solar-powered lights and fans, mosquito nets, free daily laundry service.

Children

Families are welcome at Imvelo properties but children must be under the supervision of a responsible adult at all times (we do not provide caretakers). Children under the age of 7 years are allowed by special arrangement and may be subject to private dining options and separate activities, at the sole discretion of lodge management. Children 12 years and below pay 30% of the accommodation portion only and must share with an adult. Up to two children may share a room with an adult.
